- Institute has installed ----34----- nos. CCTV Cameras at different locations uch as Institute Entrance, Library, Workshop, Student Section, Principal's Office, Parking, all corridors and Computer Centre. Two Pan Tilt and Zoom (PTZ) cameras also installed near institute entrance.
- Security guards are working 24x7.
- All corridors and laboratories are equipped with fire extinguishers.
- Pick up and drop facility is available for girl students at the time of late night events such as Techelons & Jalasaetc, held in the institute.
- Separate seating arrangement in College Canteen facility for girls and boys in the campus.
- Anti-ragging committee has been constituted and contact details of its members are displayed at prominent places.
- Vending machines for sanitary napkins are available in Girls toilet block with incinerator.
- Ambulance facility (24X7) to reach hospital in emergency medical situation is also available.

2. Counseling: -

Many times students are not in position to discuss some issues with their parents. Counseling tries to solve the problem or at least do the counseling with the best possible manner and under its judiciary. There is a grievance committee to deal with the Institute to hear and settle grievances. The major objective of the counseling is to facilitate Academic, Emotional, Socialand cognitive development of the students hence to empower them in their learning and personaldevelopment. The institute has established Students Counseling Cell for the overall development of thestudents through interaction. Mentor (faculty) will take care of about 20 students. Students are allocated to specific mentor for entire semester. Teacher guardian scheme is available for mentoring of all the students

• The Women's Grievance cell (WGC) has been formed and students are make aware of this cell and its working policy.

As per university ordinance no._77/2012 dated 21st June2012, PRPCOA have **Women's Grievance cell (WGC)** to look after the issues related to the women staffs and girl students. Not only that **WGC** also aim **to** motivate, educate, provide awareness on various socio-

economic and health issues along with prevention of sexual harassment of female student, teaching and non-teaching staff.

- Free Medical checkup camp was conducted for girls to make them aware of health issues like anemia, thyroid, mental stress & anxiety.

- To create awareness about sexual Harassment, molestation, workshops were conducted. In this workshop Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal act was discussed with students by the eminent lawyer.
- College felicitated girls students who has established their architectural practice boost the entrepreneurship.
- Every year in Technical event "Techelon" institute has tradition of inviting eminent female speakers from all over country and every domain.
- Poster competitions were held in and off the campus focusing the current issues related to females like "save girl child", women education and their empowerment, child labor etc.
